The college was established on 14.8.1981 as a private college. It was taken over by the Government of M.P. on 1.10.1982.

It is a leading college of Ujjain Division.

Library first started in a small room and afterwards, in 2006 in a hall in the premises of rented college building in Budhawaria, Ujjain.

In 2019 it was shifted into newly built building of the college near Ramjanardan Temple in a hall since library part of college building was incomplete due to corona pandemic.



In 2020 it has been re shifted to ex Madhav Arts and Commerce College, Dewas Gate, Ujjain since the newly built building at Ramjanardan Temple was situated in a remote place at 7 KM away from centre of city and was very inconvenient to girl students.



The present library building is an independent and specious. Many library facilities are being developed in it.



Miss Rehana Odniwala was first Assistant Librarian on contact basis on 1990-91. Miss Veena Sharma followed as Librarian in 13 Nov 1991 after retirement of Veena Sharma in Aug 2007 Dr. Abdual Wazid Kureshi was in-charge of Library till 20 Sep.2008. Dr. Leena Shah, presently working as Librarian from 21.8.2008. The library uses 2.0. SOUL Software from

2003. Data entry of 28824 books have been completed in SOUL software.

Year 2023-24 all 30831 books and staff and students' data entries has been done through E- Granthalaya Software.

Also has 251 E-books provided by Higher Education for access on E-Granthalaya Portal from Jan.2024.

Prepared barcodes and pasted them on spines, front page and secret pages of the useful books for circulation.

Pastes cello tape on barcodes for their security. From 2010 to 2018-19 all students and staff were provided laminated library cards with barcodes.

At present the library is providing facilities to 2431 (24-25) students of the college. Library has 30856-3476 W/O = 27380 books. Also has more than 4000 e-journals in ONOS and 6,00,000+ E-Books are accessible on line through NDLI.


